RULES

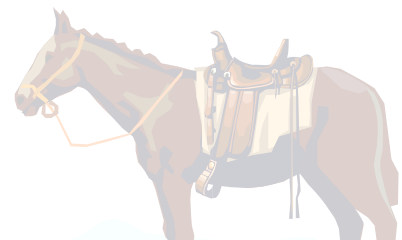
1. Midwest employees have absolute authority & reserve the right to reject any reservation.
2. All guests, day riders & visitors must register at the front desk.
3. No unauthorized vendors, this means horse trainers and folks selling stuff.
4. Only 4 people or 4 stalls allowed per site, please.
5. If you check in before NOON, you will pay for an extra night. Check-in Time 3:00pm – Check-Out Time 2:00pm. (One night's reservation fits between this time frame.)
6. One living quarters trailer per site. Site Sharing is only permitted if the second trailer is non electrical and NOT plugged in; and is less than 14' long.
5. No swimming pools on campsites.
6. Pack Out what you pack in; do not throw trash down on trails!
7. **Deposits are non-refundable** and may be transferred one time only. Transfer requests must be received 14 days prior to your arrival.
8. Coggins and 30 day health papers are required for out-of-state horses.
9. Bad check fee- \$20
10. All campers must check in at the office prior to parking your rig.
11. NO CALL/NO SHOW – you will pay for your camp site at time of invoice.
12. We are not responsible for injury, lost, damaged or stolen property.
13. Quiet Hour – 11:00pm will be enforced. Drunken, disorderly conduct will not be tolerated at MTR campground!

STALL CLEANING

STALLS MUST BE CLEANED PRIOR TO YOUR DEPARTURE OR BE CHARGED \$15.00 PER STALL.

DOG POLICY

- 1. DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH IN THE CAMPGROUND AT ALL TIMES.**
- 2. YOUR DOG IS YOUR LIABILITY. PLEASE CONSIDER WHETHER YOUR DOG IS APPROPRIATE FOR A HORSE CAMPGROUND SITUATION. IF NOT, IT IS IN YOUR BEST INTEREST TO LEAVE IT AT HOME!** You are responsible for the actions of your dog in camp or on the trail. If your dog bites someone, spooks a horse, or is somehow involved in injury to a horse or rider, you are liable. Midwest Trail Ride is not responsible for your dog's actions.
- 3. IF YOUR DOG BARKS EXCESSIVELY, YOU WILL BE ASKED TO REMOVE IT FROM THE PREMISES.** This will be enforced so all campers may have a peaceful stay.
4. CAMPSITES ARE NOT DOGGIE TOILETS. PLEASE PICKUP AFTER YOUR DOG. Nobody likes to step in doggie dodo. Please be considerate of fellow campers.
5. NO PETS ARE ALLOWED IN THE STORE OR MESS HALL !
- 6. THE DOG POLICY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. FIRST VIOLATION IS A WARNING. SECOND VIOLATION IS A WARNING. THIRD STRIKE AND YOU'RE OUT WITHOUT A REFUND!**
